

LT Matias A. Sueldo, USNR (Ret)

LT Matias A. Sueldo (Ret.) is the founder of Silene Advisors, a boutique firm providing transaction and operations advisory services to buyers and operators of privately owned lower-middle-market businesses across the United States. Previously, Matias worked as a corporate and finance attorney in New York City. He represented investors and lenders in large, complex, multi-jurisdiction transactions, typically involving countries Europe and the Western Hemisphere, but also in Africa and Asia. While practicing law in New York City, Mr. Sueldo applied and screened for a direct commission into the Navy Reserve and was assigned to a reserve unit in southern New Jersey. After moving to Denver, Mr. Sueldo used the opportunity to apply and screen for a reserve unit in San Diego supporting Naval Special Warfare. He assumed a leadership position in that unit as well and, shortly after drilling there, was mobilized to active duty with NSW. He spent about a year and half on active duty before returning to reserve duty in Denver.
